The Slaney Language Centre specifies that students must abide by the following rules during their stay with us:

- Students must arrive on time at the bus stop and at the school and attend all lessons as shown on their timetable as well as pre-booked activities and excursions.
- If students are ill they must telephone their group leader. Individual students must contact The Slaney Language Centre office at 00353-53-9120881 or 00353-87-2317270 to notify the reason for absence.
- The bus to Wexford town leaves The Slaney Language Centre at 13.45 or in the evening after activities and excursions. Dinner time is usually at 6pm. The students are allowed to spend some time on their own in Wexford town centre and walk home to their accommodation. They should take care when crossing roads and remember that in Ireland cars drive on the left.
- Underage smoking and consumption of alcohol is illegal in Ireland and won't be tolerated.
- On activities and excursions, students should wear appropriate clothing, use polite language, be attentive and speak in English at all times. Any students causing offence or acting in an unacceptable manner may forfeit their place on future activities and excursions and be subject to disciplinary procedures.
- The Slaney Language Centre reserves the right to ask a student to leave because of serious misconduct or non-payment of fees. All students and staff at The Slaney Language Centre are expected to show respect to each other at all times. The following behaviour is not acceptable: harassment, bullying, actual threats of violence, damage to personal property and verbal abuse based on racial, sexual or religious differences.

- Please observe the following laws in Ireland:
You must be over 18 to buy and consume alcohol, and to buy cigarettes.
