

## Parent / Legal Guardian Consent

This must be completed by the parent or legal guardian of any student that is 18 years of age (British Columbia, Nova Scotia)/17 years of age (Ontario, California, New York, New Jersey, Massachusetts) or younger. The participant agrees to participate in the entire program for which the student is enrolled at Oxford International North America and will follow safety instructions and all school, Host Family and/or residence Rules and Regulations. The parent or legal guardian authorizes the school and/or the Host Family to attain medical treatment for the participant in the event it is required and agrees to the decisions and instructions given. The parent or legal guardian also consents to the participation of the youth in all the scheduled youth activities and any other supervised activities associated with the program, including overnight excursions and trips.

## Minors Attending Oxford International

Students that are 18 years old (British Columbia, Nova Scotia)/17 years old (Ontario, California, New York, New Jersey, Massachusetts) or younger are considered to be minors. This means they will need to be supervised by an adult, and that in addition to abiding by Oxford International School Rules and Regulations, they must also abide by an additional set of rules that are specific to minors. These rules are as follows:

1. Minors must receive permission from their host family or legal guardian to be absent from dinner and to go out in the evenings or weekends. In the event permission is granted, they must inform their host family of their whereabouts and whom they are with give a reasonable time of return.
2. Minors must obtain permission from their host family or legal guardian to spend the night away from their host family's home. In the event permission is granted, they must give their host family the telephone number and address of where they are staying as well as the name of whom they are with.
3. Minors who are found in possession of an ID card misrepresenting their age will be expelled from the school.
4. Minors must attend all classes unless they are ill. In the event of illness their host family must call the school to notify the staff of the student's condition.
5. If a minor is under 16 years of age, they must receive permission from Oxford International North America staff to leave the school building at any point during the day.
6. If a minor is under 13 years of age, they must have supervision while travelling to and from school.
7. The transfer on arrival and departure to/from the homestay from/to the airport/ train station is mandatory for minors unless a named adult with contact details is picking up the student and dropping him/her at the homestay or airport.
8. To ensure student safety, it is mandatory for minors to book homestay accommodation with Oxford International North America for the duration of their stay. Only if an alternative Custodian and family are provided and approved by Oxford International North America, shall there be an exception to this rule.

In addition to abiding by Oxford International's Schools Rules and Regulations, minors must also abide by Canadian and American Laws. Below is a list of important Canadian and American laws that they must be aware of.

1. It is illegal for anyone under the age of 16 to drive in Canada, New York, Massachusetts and California /17 in New Jersey.
2. It is illegal for anyone under the age of 19 to buy tobacco products in Canada/18 in California, New York, New Jersey and Massachusetts.
3. It is illegal for anyone under the age of 19 to buy, be served or consume alcohol/21 in California, New York, New Jersey and Massachusetts.
4. It is illegal for anyone under the age of 19 to buy or use marijuana in Canada/21 in California and Massachusetts. Recreational marijuana is illegal in New York and New Jersey.
